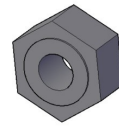

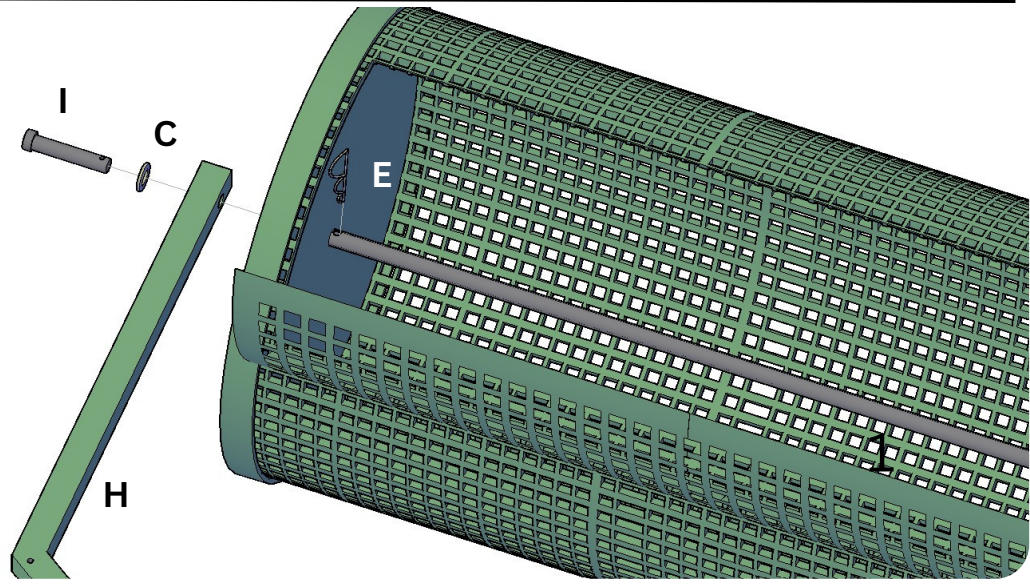
Step 1:

Remove parts from box and lay out handle components for assembly (Parts, **H** x2, **F**, **G**). See picture for more info on this configuration



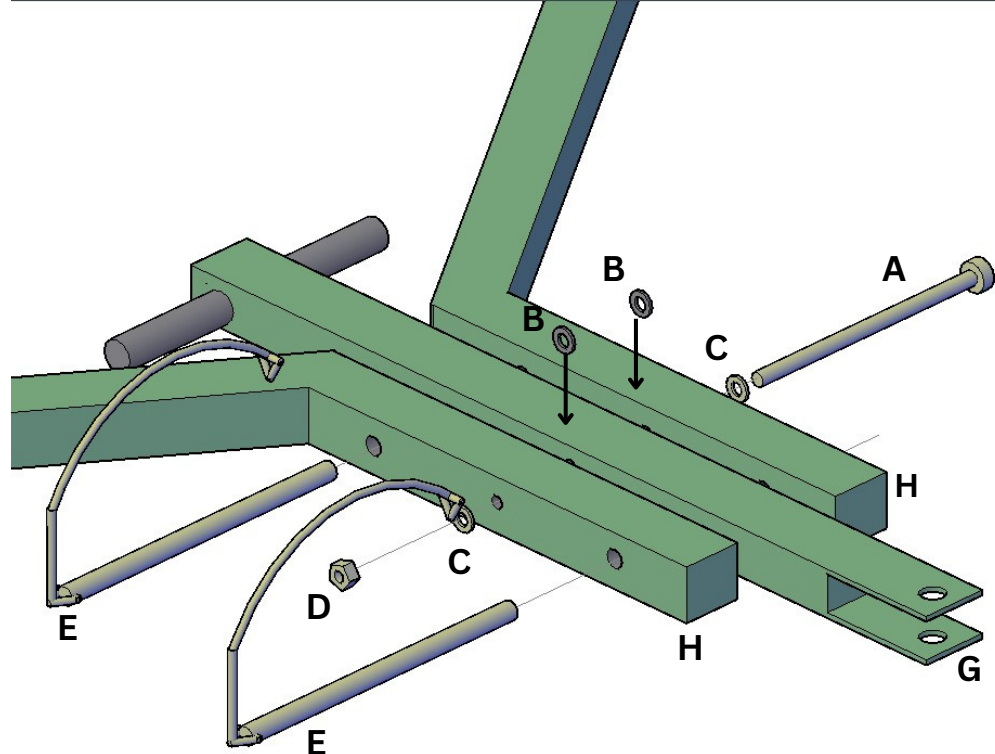
Step 2:

Align each Control Arm (**H**) with the spreader barrel mounting holes (one on each sidewall). Using a Clevis Pin (**I**) and a Flat Washer (**C**), attach the Control Arm (**H**). Line up the hole in the Clevis Pin (**I**) with the hole inside the barrel on the center bar. Insert the Hairpin Clip (**E**) into the holes to lock the Control Arm (**H**) in place. Repeat for the other sidewall.

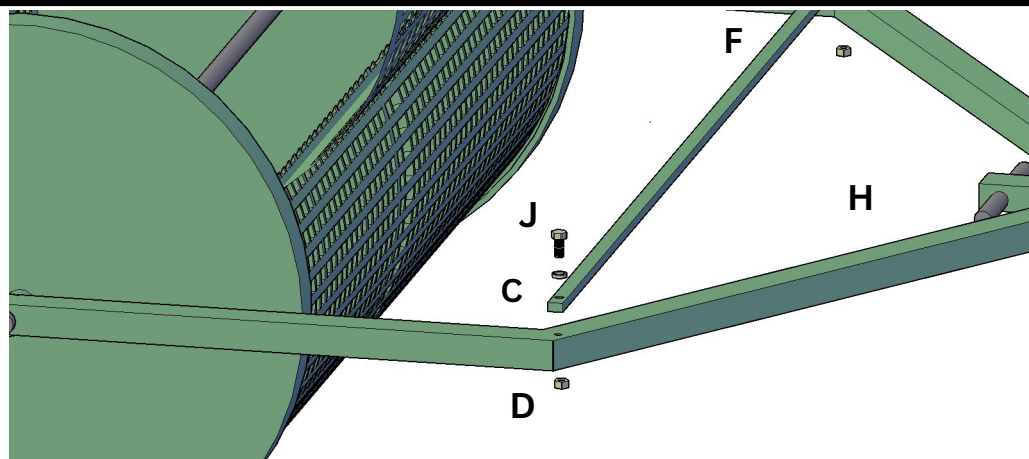


Step 3:

Place the Swivel Handle (G) between the Control Arms (H). Align the 3 holes on the Swivel Handle (G) with the 3 holes on each Control Arm (H). Put a Flat Washer (C) on the Long Hex Bolt (A) and thread it through the center hole, making sure to add Plastic Washers (B) between the Swivel Handle (G) and Control Arms (H). Tighten the Lock Nut (D) on the end of the Hex Bolt (A). The handle should swivel freely between the two control arms. Swivel the handle so the grips are facing out or the tow hitch, depending on your needs. Use the Retaining Pins (E) to lock the handle in place as shown in the diagram.

**Step 4:**

Align the holes on the support bar (F) with the holes in the middle of the Control Arms (H). Secure the support bar using Support Bar Bolt (J) x 2, Flat Washer (C) x 2, and Lock Nut (D) x 2.

**Safety Instructions**

- **Wear Protective Gear:** Always wear gloves, safety glasses, and sturdy footwear when operating the Landzie 44" Compost Spreader to protect yourself from potential injuries.
