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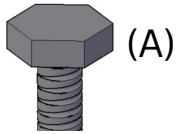


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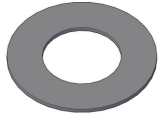

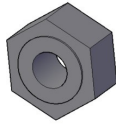
Hex Bolt (7 Inch) x2 Flat Washer x 6 Nylon Lock Nut x3 Control Arms x 2

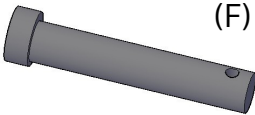

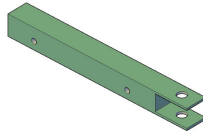

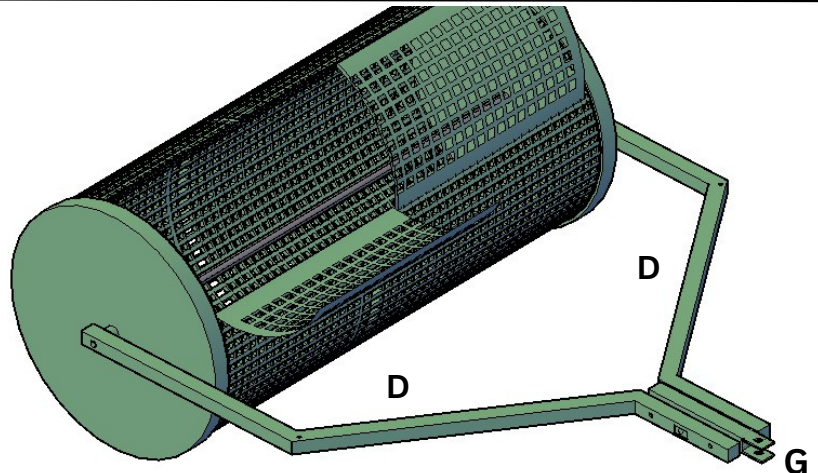
Tow Behind Attachment x1

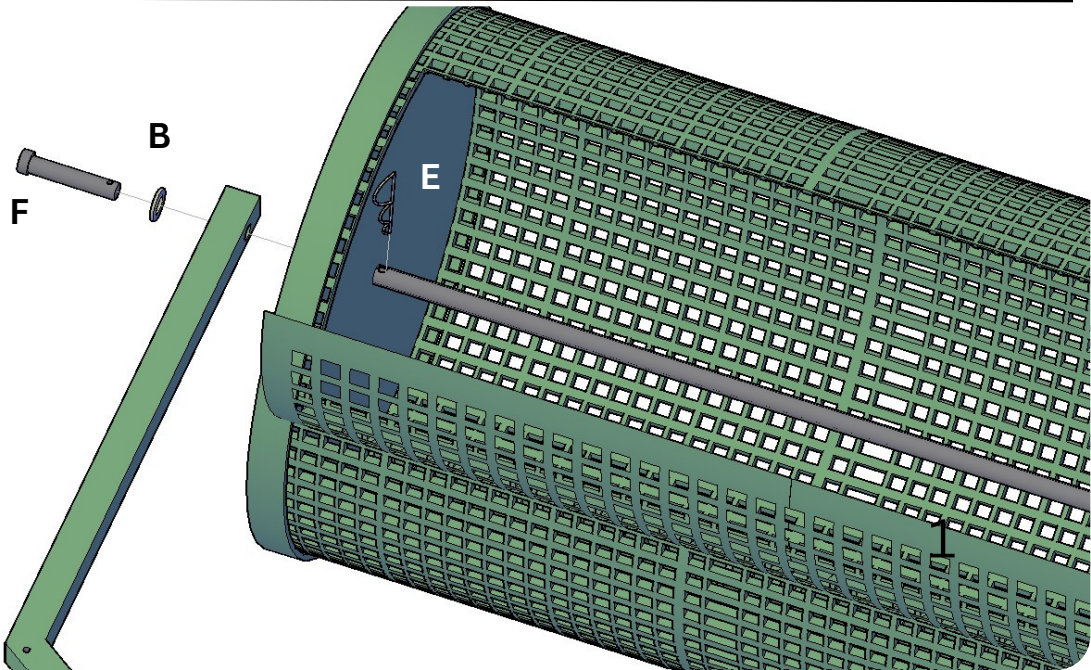
Step 1:

Place a control arm (D) on either side of the spreader barrel with the tow behind attachment (G) centered between the upper ends of both control arms.



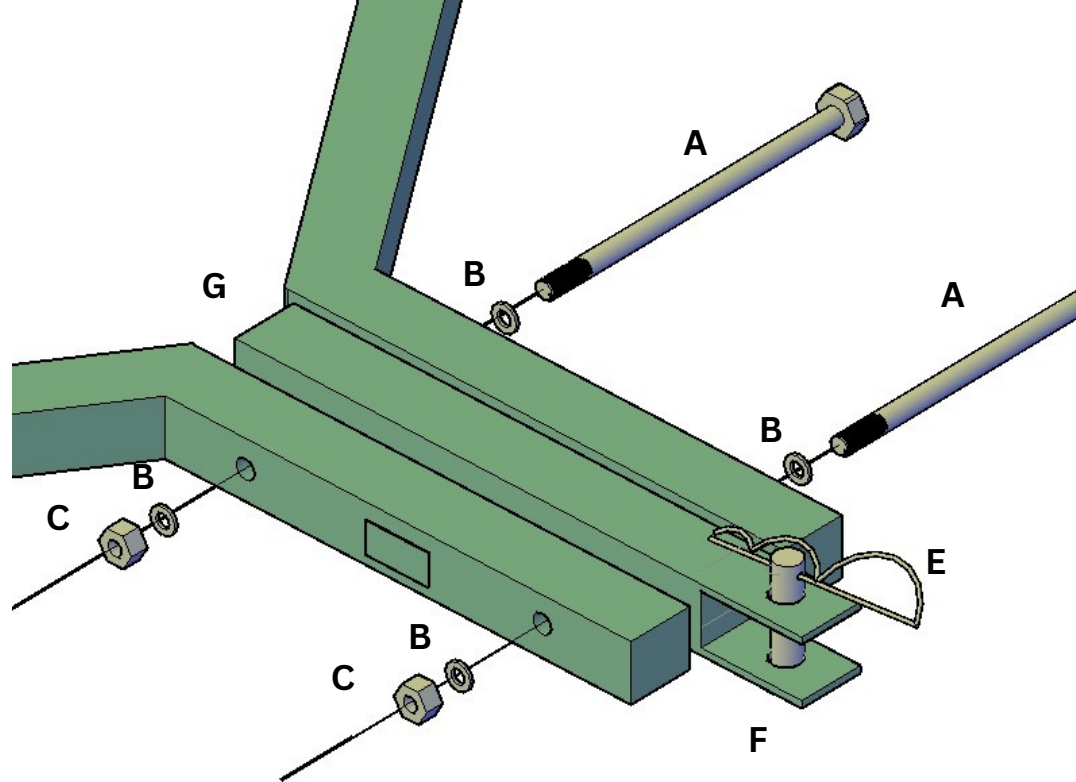
Step 2:

Align each Control Arm (D) with the spreader barrel mounting holes (one on each sidewall). Using a Clevis Pin (F) and a Flat Washer (B), attach the Control Arm (D). Line up the hole in the Clevis Pin (F) with the hole inside the barrel on the center bar. Insert the Hairpin Clip (E) into the holes to lock the Control Arm (D) in place. Repeat for the other sidewall.



Step 3:

Take both hex bolts (A) and line them up with the holes on the outside of each control arm (D). Make sure each hex bolt (A) passes through the tow behind attachment (G) along with washers on either side each control arm (D). Tighten each locknut snugly until the locknut (C) cannot be tightened further.



Safety Instructions

- **Wear Protective Gear:** Always wear gloves, safety glasses, and sturdy footwear when operating the Landzie 60" Compost Spreader to protect yourself from potential injuries.
- **Clear the Area:** Ensure the area where you will be using the spreader is clear of obstacles, debris, and other people to prevent accidents.

- **Secure Connections:** Make sure all bolts, washers, and nuts are securely fastened before operating the spreader to prevent parts from coming loose during use.
